#### United Arab Emirates to open tourist visas for vaccinated travellers from 30-Aug-2021

United Arab Emirates' National Emergency Crisis and Disaster Management Authority, via its official Twitter account, announced (29-Aug-2021) applications for tourist visas will open to fully vaccinated citizens of all countries from 30-Aug-2021. Passengers will be required to take rapid PCR tests upon arrival. (Source CAPA)

#### IATA urges states to make EU DCC their global standard for digital vaccine certificates

IATA commended (26-Aug-2021) the European Commission for its leadership and speed in delivering the EU Digital COVID Certificate (DCC) and urged states to make it their global standard for digital vaccine certificates. IATA stated the EU DCC meets several key criteria which have been identified as important if a digital vaccination certificate is to be effective:

- Format: the DCC has the flexibility to be used in both paper and digital format;
- QR code: The DCC QR code can be included in both digital and paper format. It contains essential information as well as a digital signature to make sure the certificate is authentic;
- Verification and authentication: The European Commission has built a gateway through which the encrypted data used
  to sign DCCs and required to authenticate certificate signatures can be distributed across the EU. The gateway can be
  also used to distribute encrypted data of non-EU certificate issuers other issuers. The EU has also developed a
  specification for machine readable Validation Rules for cross-country travel.

IATA reported it wishes to offer its collaboration to EU Commission and any other interested state to further integrate the DCC into airline processes for a secure and seamless passenger experience, such as support for selective disclosure of personal data. (Source CAPA)

#### IATA urges WHO to revisit its work to develop a global digital vaccine standard

IATA stated (19-Aug-2021) the harmonisation of digital vaccine standards is "essential to support the safe and scalable restart of aviation, avoid unnecessary airport queues and ensure a smooth passenger experience". The airline association welcomed the work done by the European Commission in developing the EU Digital COVID Certificate (DCC) system and thereby standardising digital vaccine certificates across Europe. Building on the success of the EU DCC, IATA has urged the World Health Organization (WHO) to revisit its work to develop a global digital vaccine standard. IATA SVP for operations safety and security Nick Careen said the "absence of a global standard makes it much harder for airlines, border authorities and governments to recognise and verify a traveller's digital vaccination certificate" and urged the WHO to look closely at the EU DCC as a "proven solution that meets WHO guidance and can help to reconnect the world". #### EU and UK digital COVID certificates recognised by IATA Travel Pass

IATA announced (19-Aug-2021) the EU Digital COVID Certificate (DCC) and UK National Health Service (NHS) COVID Pass can now be uploaded into IATA Travel Pass as verified proof of vaccination for travel. Travelers holding an EU DCC or UK NHS COVID Pass can now use the IATA Travel Pass to access accurate COVID-19 travel information for their journey, create an electronic version of their passport and import their vaccination certificate in one place. This information can be shared with airlines and border control authorities, offing them the assurance a certificate presented is genuine and belongs to the person presenting it. (Source CAPA)

#### National Aviation Services to implement Abbott rapid COVID-19 test devices at airports

National Aviation Services (NAS) signed (10-Aug-2021) an agreement with Abbott to implement Abbott's Panbio COVID-19 Ag rapid test devices and ID NOW COVID-19 rapid molecular test instruments at NAS airports in Africa and the Middle East. The portable test devices provide results within 15-20 minutes. (Source CAPA)

#### WTTC calls on US Govt to speed up approval of AstraZeneca for vital travel

World Travel & Tourism Council (WTTC) called (24-Aug-2021) on the **US** government to urgently speed up approval of the UK's AstraZeneca vaccine to help restore vital trans-Atlantic travel. WTTC said if the US Government allows borders to reopen, the CDC's non-recognition of AstraZeneca will be a significant barrier to trans-Atlantic travel between the UK and US, and continue to seriously depress consumer demand and prevent any meaningful revival of trans-Atlantic travel from the UK to the US. WTTC noted it will also continue the serious knock-on effects throughout the travel & tourism sector on both sides of the Atlantic. WTTC senior vice president Virginia Messina stated: "Unless it gives it the green light, then the US will effectively remain closed to the vast majority of UK visitors and the many millions around the world who are double-jabbed with the AstraZeneca vaccine". #### Air France extends fully-flexible ticket measures out to the end of 1st Quarter 2022

Air France announced (24-Aug-2021) the extension of the deadline for its fully flexible ticket measures. Previously valid for travel up to 31-Dec-2021, these commercial measures have now been extended to 31-Mar-2022. The measures allow Air France customers to change their booking or receive a refund at no cost and without proof up to the day of departure, or request a full refund. If the fare conditions of the ticket do not allow a refund, a credit voucher valid for one year will be issued, the refund of which can be requested at any time. (Source CAPA)

#### Emirates extends booking waiver for travel through 31-May-2022

Emirates Airline extended (23-Aug-2021) its booking waiver for travel through 31-May-2022, increasing security and flexibility for passengers amid the impacts of COVID-19. Since Mar-2020 the carrier reports over two million booking changes made under its flexible booking policies, with 92,000 customers having exchanged tickets for travel vouchers and 38,000 having flown or planning to fly using redeemed vouchers. As previously reported by CAPA, the carrier also extended Silver, Gold and Platinum Skywards memberships due to expire since Apr-2020 until 2022, and has served 7.2 million passengers under its multi risk travel insurance offer launched in Dec-2020.
